## Retail Division

### Attended Donation Centers (ADC)

In addition to the donation centers connected with retail stores, Goodwill has five attended donation centers in central Indiana. Hours for attended donation centers are 10 a.m.-6 p.m. Monday-Saturday and noon-6 p.m. on Sunday.

- The sale of donated goods helps financially support Goodwill’s employment programs in central Indiana.

## Auto Donation Program

Vehicle donations are accepted at all Goodwill stores, and pick-up service is available. Donations of automobiles are tax-deductible to the extent permitted by law.

The donated cars are sold at auto auctions conducted by Goodwill at 1300 S. Tibbs Ave. on the near west side of Indianapolis. The auction accepts cash only, and a \$100 deposit is required to bid. The \$100 is applied toward purchase or refunded without purchase. For auction dates and times, go to [www.goodwillindy.org](http://www.goodwillindy.org). Bidders may preview vehicles from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on the Friday preceding the auction.

The sale of donated vehicles helps financially support Goodwill's training and employment programs in central Indiana.

## Project Collect & Connect

Service organizations, schools, churches and businesses can help Goodwill and the community by sponsoring a Project Collect & Connect clothing drive.

For each bag of gently used women's, men's or children's clothing collected, the sponsoring group will a \$5 clothing voucher redeemable at any central Indiana Goodwill store. The sponsoring group may distribute the vouchers to families and individuals in need of clothing or give the vouchers to Goodwill for distribution to individuals participating in employment and educational services.

Clothing drives may be conducted anytime throughout the year, and Goodwill can provide bags for a drive. Organizations can choose to have a one-day, weeklong or monthlong drive and request that all bags of clothing be delivered to a specific location. Clothing drives must be scheduled for a specific period of time and cannot be conducted on an ongoing basis without an ending date.

All clothing collected at a Project Collect & drive must be donated to Goodwill. All donations are sold in central Indiana Goodwill stores. The sale of donated goods helps financially support Goodwill's employment and educational services in central Indiana.

- Goodwill has 44 Goodwill Stores in central Indiana and three Goodwill Outlet Stores.
- Donations are accepted at all stores and are tax-deductible.
- Stores sell used clothing and accessories for men, women and children as well as furniture and household items.
- The sale of donated goods helps financially support Goodwill’s employment programs in central Indiana.

### Information

- **At the Goodwill Outlet Stores, clothing, housewares, glassware and toys are sold by the pound.** All other outlet merchandise is priced as marked. Items sold by the pound in the Goodwill Outlet Stores are not pre-sorted, and customers can sort through a variety of merchandise bins. Prices are:
  - Glassware & dishware – 59 cents per pound
  - Clothing, accessories, housewares and toys –
    - \$1.39 per pound for 0-19 pounds
    - 99 cents per pound for 20-49 pounds
    - 59 cents per pound for 50 pounds or more
- Each outlet has three check-out lanes available.
- Donations of clothing and household items are accepted during store hours, and tax receipts are available.

### Policies at the Goodwill Outlet Stores

- All merchandise is sold as-is at the Goodwill Outlet Stores. All sales are final. No refunds or exchanges.
- We accept the following credit cards: MasterCard, Visa and Discover.  
(We also accept personal checks with valid I.D.)
- Goodwill's Senior Day Discount, 50% Off Storewide Sales and other designated promotions are not valid at the Goodwill Outlet Stores.

## Goodwill's Retail Warehouses

Goodwill has warehouse facilities located at its Goodwill Outlet Stores, 6650 W. Washington St. on the west side of Indianapolis, 2900 N. Shadeland Ave. on the east side of Indianapolis and the 8345 Georgetown Road on the northwest side of Indianapolis. The west side warehouse facility is 96,508 square feet, the east side facility is 108,000 square feet, and the north side facility is 100,000 square feet.

Items donated at retail stores are processed at the stores and moved onto their sales floors as quickly as possible. Surplus donations are shipped to one of Goodwill's warehouses for storage and re-distribution to one of Goodwill's stores. The surplus donations at the warehouse also are used as a source of merchandise for the stores during slow donation times. Items that do not sell in Goodwill stores get a second chance to sell at one of the Goodwill Outlet Stores.

At Goodwill warehouse facilities, salvage textiles and shoes (items that could not be sold in Goodwill stores or the Goodwill Outlet Stores) are compressed and bound in bales of approximately 900 pounds and sold to salvage textile dealers at a negotiated price per pound. The sale of salvage items helps financially support Goodwill's training and employment programs in central Indiana and prevents donations from being thrown away.

The warehouses are home to Goodwill's retail fleet, consisting of five tractors, two straight trucks and 70 trailers.
