Attention, shoppers! Central Indiana's largest Goodwill Store is set to open on Thursday, July 6. Designer clothes, brand name merchandise, books and household items are just a few of the specialties offered at 6110 N. Keystone Ave., Indianapolis, near Glendale Mall.

Doors will open at 9 a.m. Thursday, July 6, and shoppers who visit the new store will have a chance to win \$50 gift certificates July 6-8. In addition, customers who visit the new location July 6-15 can register to win an iPod or portable DVD player. Two of each will be given away as prizes.

The new store employs 45 people and boasts 15,000-square-foot sales floor, five check-out lanes and a drive-thru donation center. The store on Keystone Avenue replaces the current Broad Ripple Attended Donation Center at 2134 E. 62nd St., which closes Wednesday, July 5. Hours for the new store are 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Saturday and noon to 6 p.m. on Sunday.

Retail sales help fund Goodwill's employment programs in central Indiana. In 2005, Goodwill helped 8,370 people in central Indiana find jobs. Goodwill stores accept a variety of donations, including gently used clothing and other household items for resale in its stores. Donations to Goodwill are tax deductible, and receipts are available upon request.
