

Transitional Employment Program

Who: Transitional Employment is designed for individuals who have limited job skills and work histories.

What: The Transitional Employment program provides time-limited, paid job opportunities at Goodwill or in a community business setting. Transitional Employment provides individuals with short-term work experiences that will enable them to choose career paths, develop positive work habits, build a stable work histories and form positive/healthy work attitudes.

Program Goals:

- To provide individuals with “transitioning” steps that help them move toward long-term employment within the community.
- To help individuals and families become economically self-sufficient and gain economic independence.
- To equip individuals with the knowledge to access community resources in a constructive manner.
- To expand work experiences and job opportunities through collaborative relationships with businesses, schools and other organizations.

Where: Goodwill Industries of Central Indiana, 413 N. Tremont St., Indianapolis, is the primary work site for this program. Additional work experiences are developed and maintained within the community through various business settings.
